

Your Degree Pathway

A degree in Business Economics requires the completion of 90 Credits for a Bachelor's Degree. Your courses will consist of Major, General Education, and Elective Courses.

First Year

First year will introduce you to the university environment, provide you with general education courses, and allow options for you to study courses aligned with your own interests.



Business Economics Courses: Introduction to Microeconomics, Introduction to Macroeconomics, Introduction to Mathematical Economics I and II

General Education Courses: Humanities, Social Sciences or Natural Sciences (for non-science students)

Elective Courses: Your choice of courses outside of Business Economics

Second Year

In your second year, you will continue your development in the fundamentals of Business Economics.

Third Year
